AMENDED APPLICATION

COMES NOW Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc., (Operator No. 10459) a wholly owned subsidiary of SM Energy Company (Operator No. 81500) ("SM Energy")¹ ("Extraction" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, Brownstein, Hyatt, Farber, Schreck, LLP, and makes this application to the Energy and Carbon Management Commission of the State of Colorado ("ECMC" or "Commission") for an order to pool interests for the drilling of 26 new horizontal wells to be developed from one multi-well pad on the below-described lands ("Application Lands"), for the development and operation of the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations (the "Draco OGDG"):

A reference map is included herewith.

In support thereof, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of

Colorado and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.

2. Applicant is an Owner as defined by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Act and Commission Rules and owns leasehold interests or holds the right to operate on the Application Lands.

3. Rule 401.a of the Rules and Regulations of the Energy and Carbon Management Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply.

4. On April 25, 2025, the Commission entered Order No. 407-3700, which approved an approximate 3,951.25-acres Oil and Gas Development Plan ("OGDP") for the Draco OGD, for the drilling of 26 new horizontal wells, with no more than 17 wells producing from the Niobrara Formation and no more than nine wells producing from the Codell Formation, to be drilled from one multi-well pad (Location ID 489708), for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations. On March 26, 2025, the Commission entered Order No. 407-3701 which, among other things, 1) vacated Order Nos. 407-2449 and 407-2770, 2) established an approximate 3,931.80-acre drilling and spacing unit for the E $\frac{1}{2}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$, Lot 1 (76.96), Lot 2 (77.12) (All) of Section 19 and E $\frac{1}{2}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$, Lot 1 (78.04), Lot 2 (79.68) (All) of Section 30, Township 1 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 22, All of Section 23, All of Section 24, All of Section 25, the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27 of Township 1 North, Range 69 West, 6th P.M. and no more than seventeen (17) horizontal wells to be drilled in the Niobrara Formation and with no more than nine (9) horizontal wells to be drilled in the Codell Formation, within the unit for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations, 3) provided that the productive interval of any wellbore will be located no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the unit, and no closer than 300 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing within the same formation or common source of supply within the unit, unless consent is granted pursuant to Rule 401.c or Rule 408.u.(1), and 4) provided that the proposed wells shall be located on the Draco Pad (Location ID 489708) located within the Application Lands. (the "Draco DSU"). In Order No. 407-3701, the Commission confirmed that there are existing vertical, directional, or horizontal wells currently producing or shut-in from or permitted to the Niobrara and Codell Formations within all or portions of the Application Lands, and that the operation of these wells is not affected by the Draco OGD, and that any such wells shall continue to be governed, and proceeds shall continue to be distributed, in accordance with their applicable rules and orders.

5. On August 25, 2025, Applicant submitted an Amended Spacing and Amended Oil & Gas Development Plan Application, Docket No. 250800165, that seeks Commission approval of a revised configuration of the Draco DSU. ("Request for Amendment"). The revised configuration was deemed necessary to better reflect the Applicant's leasehold position relative to pooling while still preventing waste and protecting correlative rights. The Application Lands in this Application are consistent with the revised acreage identified in the Request for Amendment. The Request for Amendment is pending before the Commission.

6. ~~There are no Local Government unleased interests within the Application Lands. As of the filing date of this Application, the Town of Erie, which is a Local Government as defined by C.R.S. § 34-60-116(9), owns mineral interests that are located within the Town~~

~~of Erie's geographic boundaries and the DSU. These mineral interests are unleased. Extraction continues to engage with the Town of Erie with respect to its status as an unleased mineral owner. Extraction will file supplemental testimony confirming any agreement reached between it and the Town of Erie.~~

7. Pursuant to and consistent with Order Nos. 407-3700 and 407-3701, Applicant submitted applications for permits-to-drill ("APDs") for twenty-six (26) horizontal wells (collectively referred to as the "Wells") for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations:

8. Applicant, pursuant to Commission Rule 506 and/or the provisions of § 34-60-116(6) and (7), C.R.S., hereby requests an order to subject additional interests in the Application Lands, including any non-consenting interests therein, for the development and operation of the Wells in the Application Lands. Applicant does not intend to pool or subject any parties to cost recovery penalties for any subsequent wells other than the Wells defined in this application.

9. Applicant requests that the Commission's pooling order be made effective as of the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Wells to the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations on the Application Lands.

10. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application and Notice of Hearing will be served on all persons owning an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled as required by Rule 504.b.(3), and that at least ninety (90) days prior to the hearing on this matter, each such interest owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled has been offered the opportunity to lease or to participate in the drilling of the respective Wells, and has been provided with the information required by Rule 506 as applicable.

11. Applicant certifies that, based on its reasonable diligence, as of the date of filing Applicant owns over 45% of the mineral interests in the Application Lands to be pooled by the Application, and therefore the Application complies with the requirements of § 34-60-116(6)(b)(I), C.R.S. Applicant further certifies that it is not seeking to pool the interests of an unleased local government in the Application Lands.

12. With this Application, Applicant submits an Affidavit pursuant to § 34-60-116(6)(b)(I), C.R.S. attached as Exhibit A. Applicant certifies that the Affidavit meets the requirements of § 34-60-116(6)(b)(I), C.R.S.

13. Applicant further certifies that all unleased mineral interest owners of record have been tendered, no less than ninety (90) days before the hearing, a reasonable lease offer, made in good faith, to lease upon terms no less favorable than those currently prevailing in the area at the time application for the order is made, and that such unleased mineral owners have been furnished in writing the owners' share of the estimated drilling and completion cost of the Wells, the location and objective depth of the Wells, and the estimated spud date for the Wells or range of time within which spudding is to occur. Further, Applicant certifies that the lease offers included a copy of the Commission's pooling brochure. Therefore, the Application complies with the requirements of § 34-60-116(7)(d)(I), C.R.S.

14. Applicant further certifies that election letters and offers to participate in the Wells were sent to the working interest owners in accordance with the requirements of Rule 506 no later than ninety (90) days prior to hearing on the Application. In addition, the election letters were sent with an Authority for Expenditure (AFE) and an Election Form in accordance with Rule 506. Accordingly, the requirement to make an offer to participate has been met.

15. With this Application, Applicant has submitted sworn testimony pursuant to Rule 505 including representative copies of the offers to lease and to participate evidencing compliance with § 34-60-116, C.R.S. and ECMC Rule 506, in addition to a well plat for each Well, a list of interested parties, and the AFE for each Well. Applicant will supplement its sworn testimony with a list of parties that may be subject to the statutory cost recovery penalties of § 34-60-116, C.R.S. for the Wells.

16. In order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, additional interests in the Application Lands should be pooled for the development and operation of the Wells in the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations, including any non-consenting interests therein.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing in accordance with applicable Rules, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order to:

A. Issue an Order for pooling that pools all interests in the proposed amended approximate 3,691.80-acre drilling and spacing unit established through Order No. 407-3701 for the Application Lands, for the drilling of the Wells for the development and operation of the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations.

B. Provide that the Commission's pooling order is made effective as of the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Wells to the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations in the Application Lands.

C. Provide that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Wells, or who fails to fulfill their election through timely payment of proportionate expenses, are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to § 34-60-116(6) and (7), C.R.S. and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof with respect to the Wells drilled to develop the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations in the drilling and spacing unit comprising the Application Lands.

D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

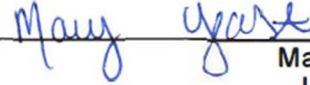

AMENDED REFERENCE MAP INCLUDING THE CROSSROADS

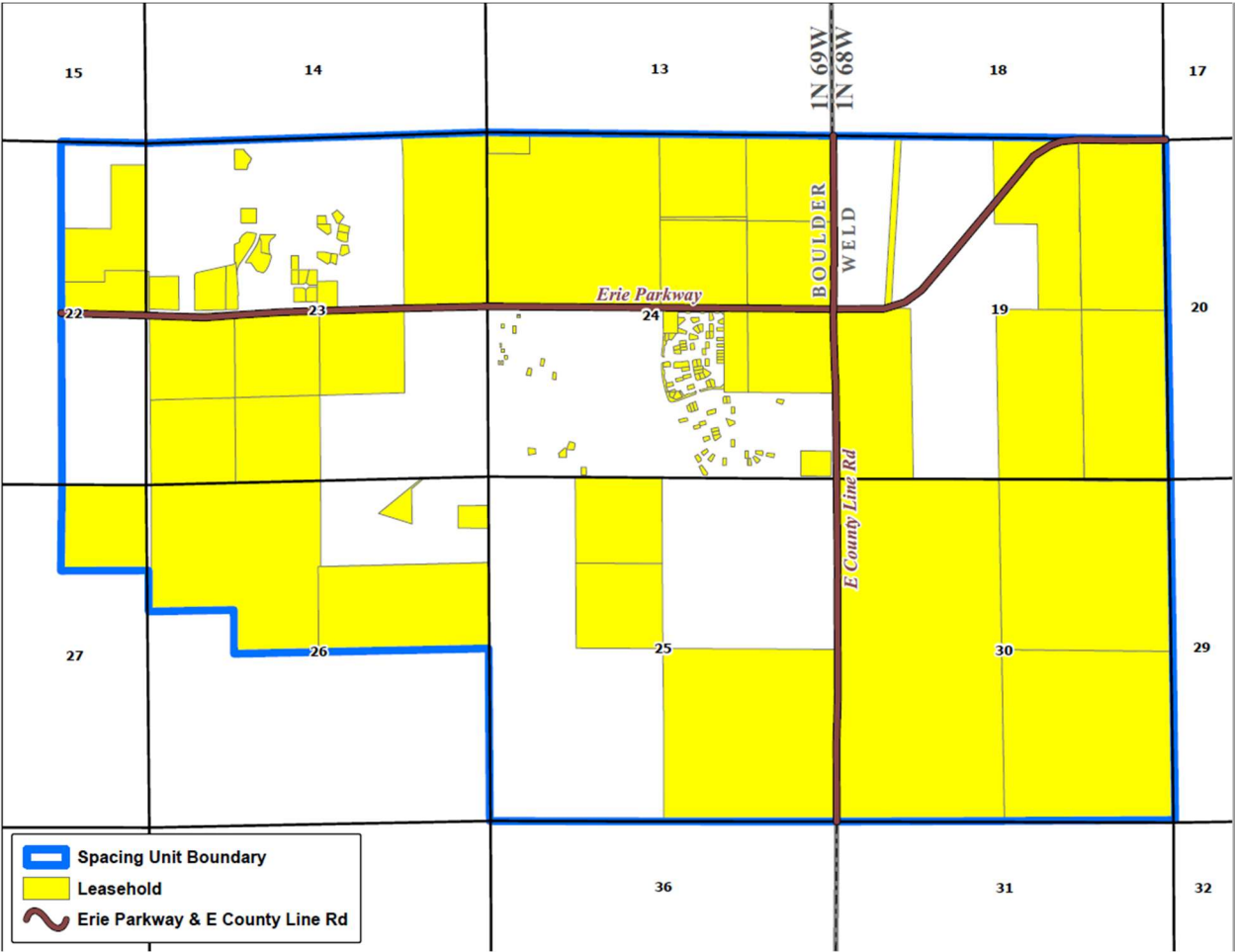
